All India Road Transport Workers' Federation strongly condemns the illegal and undemocratic suspension of 8 MPs of Upper house of Parliament. Expression of dissent is the Fundamental Right guaranteed under the Constitution of India. Members of the Parliament has the Right to demand the Government for a division on any disputed Bill. Records states that even one MP demands for Division, voting should take place.
