Sub: Representation- submission of representation on the spike in Petroleum Products prices- Requested to take immediate decision to roll back-Reg.

We would like to draw your kind attention on the regular enhancement of Petroleum Products prices. It has become the order of the day to enhance the prices of petroleum products. At a time when the COVID 2nd wave is shaking the country and the people are in serious distress, the enhancement of petroleum products prices is highly condemnable. It is nothing but war against the people of the nation. AIRTWF appeals to your authority to step up immediately and direct the Oil Companies to roll back the enhanced prices. It is further requested to withdraw the steep hike in excise duty levied in March & May 2020 to a tune of Rs.16 &13 on Diesel and Petrol per litre respectively.

It is a well-established fact that the Transport is the life line of any economy in the World. Particularly, during the COVID Pandemic, it is unimaginable to assume the economy without Transport. Each and every rupee increase in the Petroleum Products will badly hit all the prices of essential commodities. Further, during the Pandemic period there are many restrictions in several places on public Transport. Hence the poor and middle class are compelled to depend on personal mode of transport which is cutting the pockets of megre earnings.

It is not out of place to mention that the Road Transport Industry ie passenger and goods was in crisis before the Pandemic. Most of the operators are single vehicle owners and are facing severe hardships even to manage the running expenditure. Pandemic has fuelled the crisis. In addition, the Government of India and the Oil Companies have imposed heavy burdens by enhancing the Excise Duty and the
