We would like to draw your attention to the subject under reference. The IRDA is enhancing the Insurance premium every year with effect from 1st April. During the last 4 years the premium rates are almost doubled. The vehicle owners particularly the single commercial vehicle owners of Auto Rickshaw, Taxi, Truck and Private Bus are burdened heavily and are suffering a lot for their survival. Serious unrest is prevailing among commercial vehicle owners on this irrational and abnormal increase.

In this situation, AIRTWF filed a petition under RTI Act with the IRDA seeking the details of the total amount collected as premium and the amount paid as compensation to the Road Accident victims for the year 2014-15. Surprisingly, thee IRDA replied that they are not having the details. Again AIRTWF filed an appeal with the Appellate Authority of IRDA. Ironically, Appellate Authority also didn't disclose the details.

It is the fundamental question that how the IRDA is enhancing the premium rates without having details and what are the criteria for the increase.

In view of the above, we request you to intervene and the insurance premium rates are reduced and the details are kept in public domain with transparency accountability by the IRDA.

We hope your Authority will pay attention to this vital and serious issue and protect the interest of crores of vehicle owners.
